Dr.Sanjeev Anand in September 2019. Dr. Sanjeev Anand guided us through to the process of BOA congress meet, visa procedure , hospital accommodation and fellowship stay.

I also had a chance to interact with other senior orthopaedic surgeons like dr Emerton ,dr veysi, dr pandit,dr whitwell apart from dr anand and pick there brains.

I also had an opportunity to observe clinics of Dr. Sanjeev Anand and dr whitwell and learn emaculate history taking and meticulous examination.

I also got a chance to attend cases with Dr Emerton performing Kinematic alignment TKR and cementless UKA. He explained to us the concepts of kinematic TKA and steps of performing the surgery. Able to observe debridement of infected knee done, Revision hip and knee

arthroplasty cases with Dr T. Veysi and Dr Whitwell. Had an amazing experience at Leeds

learning new surgical techniques and advances in patient care.

are good to explore it by travelling to London and Scotland.
