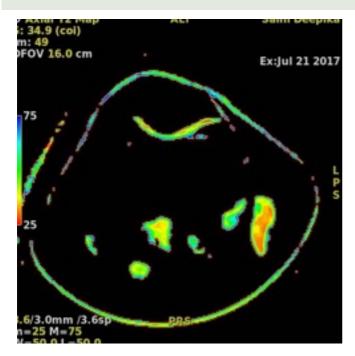
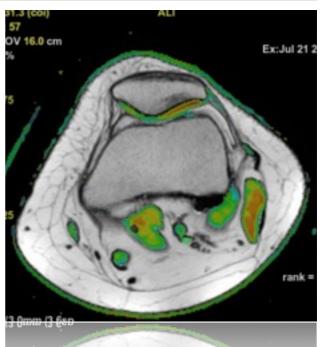

At ... And How?

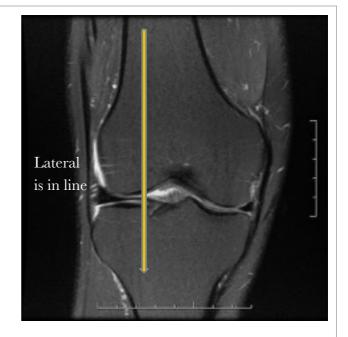
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- HAVE A MENTAL FLOW CHART
- LOOK FROM OUTSIDE TO INSIDE
- SEE ALL CORNERS
- IDENTIFY EVERY MRI SEQUENCE CORRECTLY
- ALWAYS SEE A PATHOLOGY IN AT LEAST 2 DIFFERENT PLANES
- LOCATE YOURSELF CORRECTLY AND QUICKLY WHEN SWAPPING THROUGH IMAGES.





Medial side of the knee (above) & Lateral side of the knee (below)

FAT SAT PD AND STIR

BONE IS DARK
MARROW IS DARK
FLUID IS BRIGHT, LOOK AT
LIGAMENTS, MENISCI,
TENDON

T1 AND T2/PD

BONE IS BRIGHT
MARROW IS WHITE
DIFFERENCE IN T1 AND T2
FLUID IS BRIGHT IN T2



JUST LIKE GOOGLE MAPS

Medial Condyle

TOWARDS THE MIDDLE LIKE A ISOCELES TRIANGLE

Lateral Condyle

ALWAYS IN LINE WITH FEMUR LIKE AN INVERTED L – L FOR LATERAL

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T1 CORONAL: YOUR FIRST LOOK

- BEST FOR BONES!
- FRACTURES, FRAGMENTS, LOOSE BODIES
- GOOD FOR FAT!
- LOOK AT THE MARROW, SYNOVIUM, SUBCUTANEOUS TISSUES
